Bananas

Steady supply with good quality

Broccoli, Cauliflower, Broccolini, Brussels Sprouts, and Green Onions

Broccoli – Supplies are tight due to weather and poor yields

Cauliflower-Supplies are tight due to weather and poor yields, large sizing inventory very low, pricing is up

Broccolini – Supplies are improving

Brussels Sprouts- supply has improved

Green Onions – Market has stabilized

Berries

Strawberries – quality and supply are back and forth with heat

Raspberry - supply and quality is down

Blackberries – Supply is gapping due to weather and transitions

Blueberries – Supply is improving

Product is at normal supply

Eggplant

Recent frost has affected some local product. Some farmers seasons have ended because of it.

Grapes

Volumes is steady.

Lettuce

Romaines- Supply is trending lower than usual, with fair quality

Green and Red Leaf – Supplies are being affected by recent heat

Iceberg lettuce - Supplies are down

Butter lettuce – Good volume



Melons

Cantaloupe - Production is way down with smaller fruit and less sugar

Honeydew – same as cantaloupe

Pineapple

Good availability and quality

Potatoes

Idaho - supplies are tight on larger size and prices are higher than normal due to the delayed planting earlier this year caused by the weather.

Yukon bakers - Availability is limited and pricing remaining higher than normal

Russet - Quality is getting better while pricing is coming down - two months

Kennebec - Very short right now and the quality is fair at best.

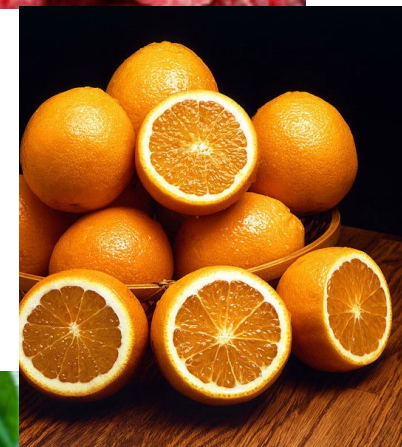
